

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Occupational Therapists work to improve your safety and independence in your home and community. They conduct individualised assessments to gain an understanding of your capabilities, restrictions, goals and motivations. Occupational Therapists prescribe interventions such as training, assistive technology, and mobility equipment to allow you to engage safely in your environment.



WHEN SHOULD YOU SEE AN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

- Needing equipment to assist with independence
- Minor home modifications e.g. grab rails and stair lifts
- Home safety assessment

- Cognitive concerns and other support needs for dementia
- Prescribing equipment to reduce falls risks
- Assistive technology for daily tasks

AN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST CAN...

- Assess and prescribe safe and effective equipment and assistive technology.
- · Assist with training and practice following the delivery of a mobility scooter or powered wheelchair.
- Provide treatment and strategies to assist with cognitive changes.
- Provide full home assessment to encourage safety and independence.
