

Dear Village Friends,

Further to our previous communications (dated 5 July), the Queensland Premier and Chief Health Officer have just made the following announcement:

Restrictions for South East Queensland will continue for a further 7 days - face mask and gathering restrictions, including visitor restrictions for residential aged care will continue to apply across these regions.

We understand the impact this has on the life of our Village of Friends community including our Residents within Hibernian and Sunnyside Villas where visitor restrictions will remain in place. The below requirements and restrictions will continue to be in place until Friday 23 July unless otherwise updated.

The regulations are as follows:-

- Face masks: masks must be worn in indoor spaces where you can't physically distance. You must carry a face mask with you at all times whenever you leave your home unless you have a lawful reason not to.
- You must be seated when eating or drinking at a café or restaurant.
- Private gatherings: 30 people maximum including residents, visitors and children.
- All indoor settings: 1 person per 4 square metres or 100% capacity with ticketed and allocated seating.
- Weddings: up to 100 people with 1 person per 4 square metres, limited to 20 people dancing at any one time.
- Funerals: up to 100 people with 1 person per 4 square metres

We provide further clarification following with reference to the BallyCara Retirement Village.


BALLYCARA RETIREMENT VILLAGE

- **In line with Government regulations, gatherings must be capped at 30 within the home.**
- **The Wellness Reception will continue as per normal opening hours.**
- **The Village office will open for standard hours Monday to Friday.**

- **Contractors providing services must continue to check in at Wellness Reception.**
- **The Emergency Response Team, Home Care and Wellness services will continue to be provided to Residents in their own homes as requested.**
- **Carrying a Face Mask whilst outside your home is required and wearing of this mask required as per previously mentioned guidelines.**
- **The BallyCara Wellness Centre Café and Gym will be open standard hours**
- **All health clinic services continue.**
- **Upon entry of the Wellness Centre - necessary screening and check in will be required. Staff will be available to assist.**
- **Both pools will be open however we ask you to maintain social distancing requirements at all times**
- **The Dining Room remains open – masks can be removed whilst dining.**
- **The Shopping Bus continues with the normal schedule – the wearing of a mask whilst on the bus and within the supermarket will be required along with checking in using the Qld COVID Check in App.**
- **All Village Activities including Happy Hour, Games, and Library resume however please ensure social distancing requirements are maintained and masks only removed whilst seated.**
- **Chapel Services as per normal schedule. Wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing are required.**

We ask for your adherence to these measures for the safety and wellbeing of our village community at this time. Should you have any questions please seek clarification from the Village Services team.
